Description:

Mimms Museum currently seeks a student interested in helping to grow the public programs offerings in alignment with the museum's mission. Public programs include events such as workshops, speakers, or similar in-house activities.

This person will be asked to:

- 1. Assist Museum staff with the continuation of existing programs and the creation of new programs that would be of interest to museum visitors of all ages
- 2. Research and communicate with potential contacts such as speakers or workshop facilitators
- 3. Take photos during these events and other activities to use in marketing campaigns
- 4. Assist with the creation of marketing materials for the events

This internship is a wonderful opportunity for someone interested in pursuing a career in project management or museum studies. This is an unpaid internship and is considered a volunteer position.

Schedule:

The intern would work a minimum of 10 hours per week for a semester or other agreed upon time period. The hours may be worked in a combination of times and days, both onsite or remote.
